

BVCC Email Services



The **bvres.org** web host can provide Bristol Village Computer Club members with their own email address. This address will remain constant no matter what ISP (Internet Service Provider) or email software you use, or might change to in the future. For basic information about email, review the topic in the BVCC Schoolhouse Tutorials.



All email addresses have the form ***name@domain*** where *domain* is the mail box location. Addresses for bvcc members can be in the form ***lastname.n@bvres.org*** or they can have any *name* you choose, or they can have the same *name* as the name you used with some other email provider.

One advantage of the **bvres.org** email address is that if you forget your password, have problems, or need assistance, you will not have to talk to someone in India, or wherever. Contact the BVCC Webmaster or a Computer Club officer to establish a **bvres.org** mail box.

If you want to maintain more than one mail box, the BVCC Webmaster can set your **bvres.org** mail box to automatically forward mail to a different address.

Keep in mind that any program for reading email, such as Thunderbird, Outlook, Gmail, etc. can be set to use a **bvres.org** mail box.

Mail in a **bvres.org** mail box can be read from any computer connected to the Internet. The BVCC Schoolhouse Tutorials Email section has instructions on how to receive mail from a **bvres.org** address book from any Internet connected computer.
