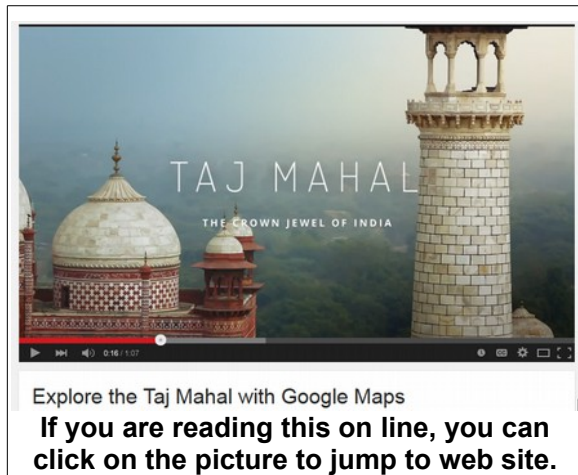

## **World Computer Traveling**

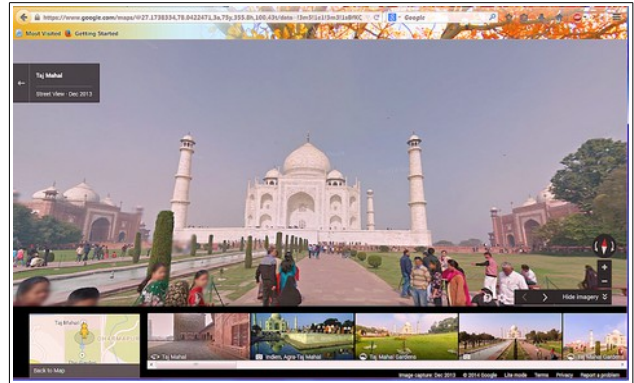

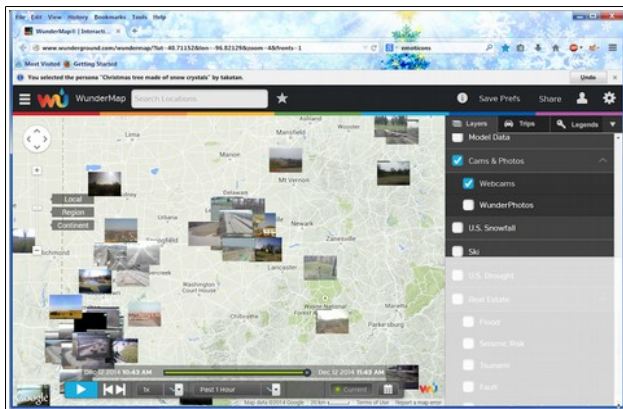

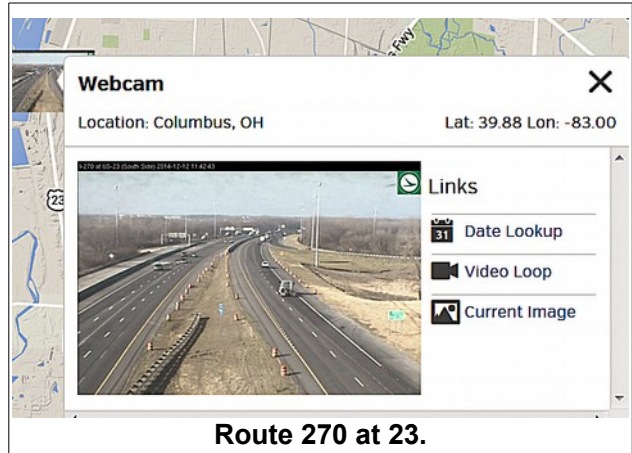
## Ohio Traffic Cameras

If you are doing any driving this winter, it is nice to see what the road conditions are around the area. The [Wundermap](#) web site provides access to Ohio traffic cameras.



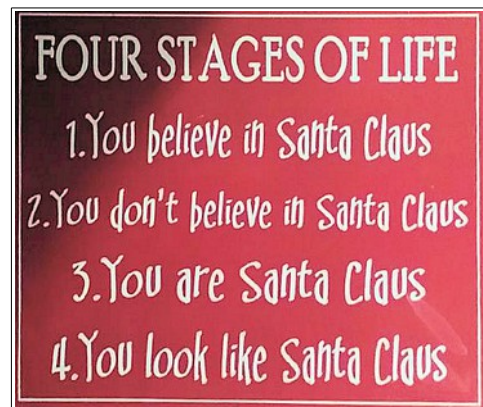
Use the + option to zoom in on an area. Scroll down on the list to turn the webcam option on.

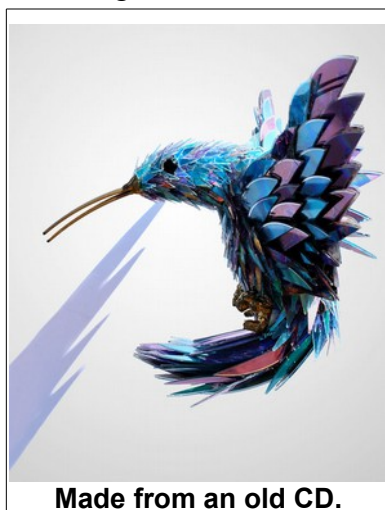
